09/76 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received from Councillor Julia Graham as she had work commitments.

09/77 DECLARATIONS OF PERSONAL OR PREJUDICIAL INTERESTS IN ITEMS ON THE AGENDA

Councillors Nunn and Turner declared a personal interest in agenda item 11- Go Kart Courses for young people as they were friends of Jim Hazelgrove who owns the Oval Race Track. Councillor Stephenson declared a personal interest in agenda item 10a) as her son is a potential Youth Councillor.

09/78 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES

Councillor Chris Verrinder said the date of the next Policy and Finance meeting should read 1st March 2010 (minute ref: 09/68a). The minutes of the Leisure Committee held on 27th January 2010 were approved and signed by the Chairman.

09/80 ANGMERING SPORTS AND RECREATION ASSOCIATION

Councillor Turner reported that the next meeting with ASRA would be 23rd February and she would report back to the committee at the next meeting. ASRA had been using the 'Community Payback Scheme' for some repairs and were so far pleased with their work. A central heating pipe in the ceiling had burst causing some damage. The parish Council had submitted the invoice to the insurance company for the remedial work but were awaiting a second quote from ASRA for the re-decoration.

MAPS AND NOTICEBOARDS

- a) The committee discussed the need to update the village maps with new additions such as the Community Centre. The committee decided to wait and see if other things needed to be added in due course which would justify the cost. The Highway Committee have agreed to install road signs to the Community Centre which should help the situation.
- b) The Senior Assistant Clerk reported that the notice boards at the Community centre and Downs Way, were causing problems, they were letting in water and the doors were not opening easily. Some work had been done but the problems persist. The Committee asked the office to get costings for replacement boards to be discussed at the next meeting.
